

# HOW TO GET A DRIVER'S LICENSE, ID, BIRTH CERTIFICATE, OR TAKE THE DRIVER'S EXAM FOR FREE IN NEVADA

Are you living in unstable housing? Unstable housing includes staying with other people because you don't have a steady place; staying in a motel, shelter, or transitional living program; and sleeping outside or in a public space.



This flowchart doesn't apply to you. You may be eligible for another fee waiver, but not this one.



Are you 24 years old or younger? Or are you the parent or guardian of someone 24 years old or under who needs a driver's license, ID, birth certificate, or to take the driver's exam?



This flowchart doesn't apply to you. You may be able to get a free birth certificate, duplicate driver's license, or duplicate ID, but the rules are different for people over age 24.



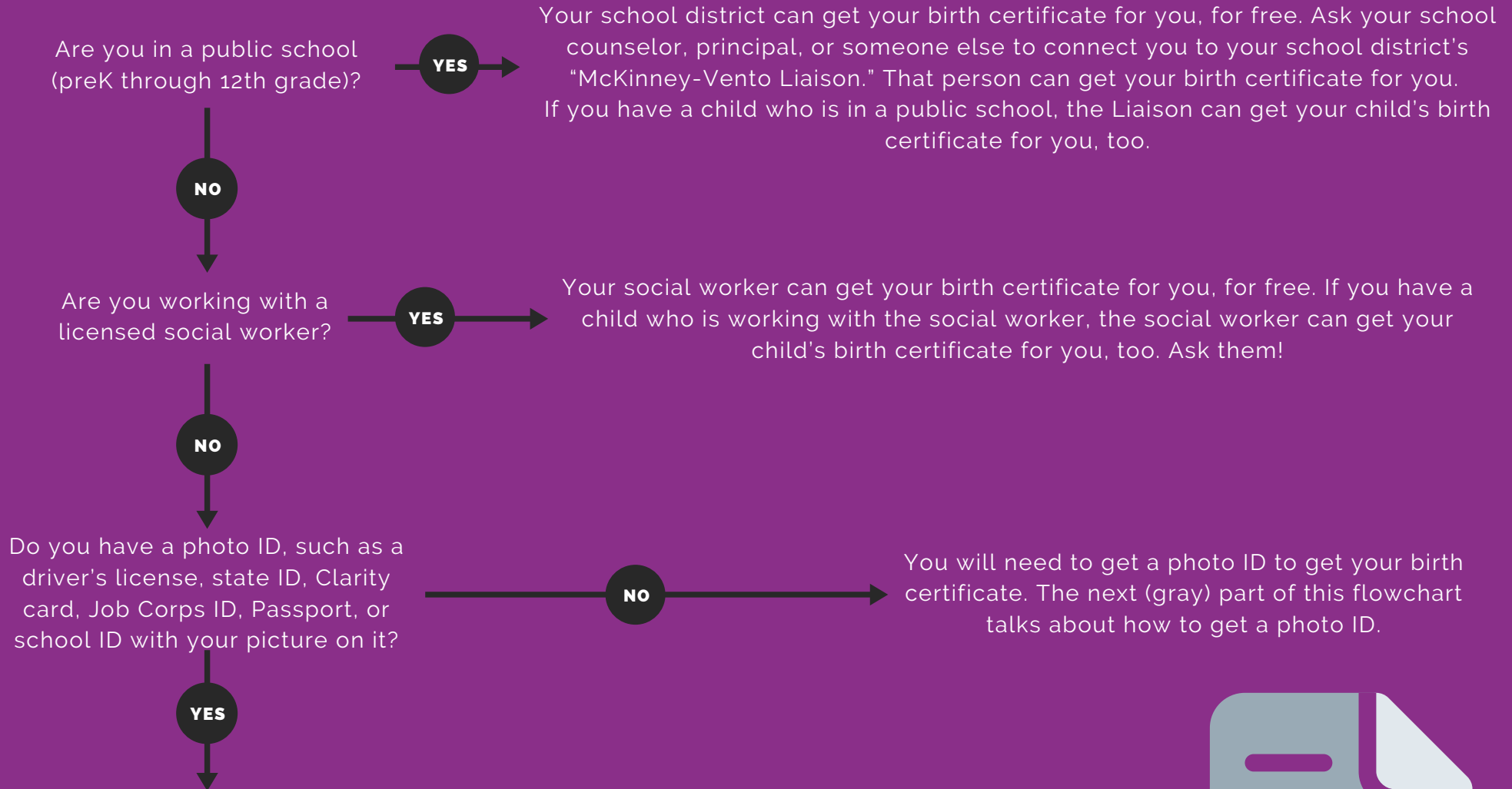
This flow chart will walk you through the steps for a birth certificate (purple), a driver's license or ID (gray), or the driver's exam (blue).

## HOW TO GET A BIRTH CERTIFICATE



**YOU CAN GET YOUR FREE BIRTH CERTIFICATE, OR A FREE PROOF OF AGE CERTIFICATE FOR WORK OR SCHOOL, IF YOU COMPLETE THIS APPLICATION AND A FEE WAIVER FORM (COMING SOON), GET THEM BOTH NOTARIZED, AND MAIL THEM TO:**

**HOW TO GET A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR ID**

To get a driver's license or ID card for free, you need to fill out this form AND this application.

You also will need to prove your identity by providing one of these documents:

- A state-issued driver's license or ID from another state
- Birth certificate (certified)
- US Passport

Do you have one of those documents? **NO** → You will have to get one of those documents. There is information about how to get a birth certificate in the purple part of this flowchart.

**YES**

You also will need to prove your Social Security number by providing one of these documents:

- Your Social Security card
- A W-2 or 1099 tax form from your job
- A printed pay stub from your job.

Do you have one of those documents? **NO** → You will have to get one of those documents, unless you have never been issued a Social Security number. If you have never had a Social Security number, you must attest to this on the driver's license or ID application.

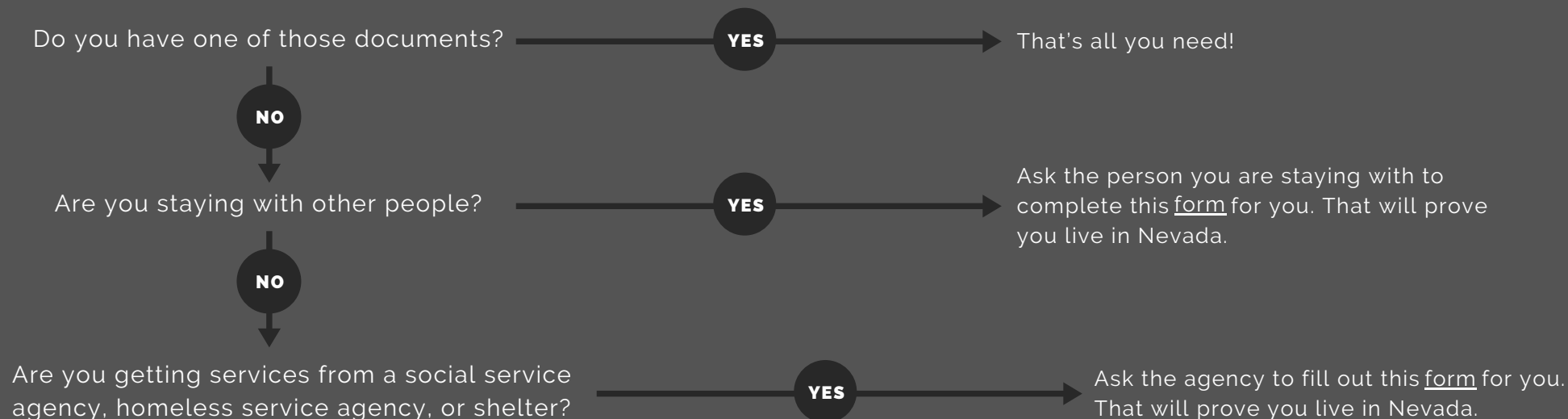
**YES**

You also will have to fill out this form, and prove that you live in Nevada. Here are some documents you can use to prove you live in Nevada (you only need ONE of these):

- A student ID or enrollment records from a Nevada school or college
- Motel, hotel, campground or recreational vehicle park receipts showing that you have been living in Nevada for at least 30 days in a row
- A document showing you receive public assistance or benefits from the State of Nevada
- A bank or credit card statement
- A paycheck stub
- A document from a state or federal court
- A record, receipt or bill requesting payment
- A Nevada Voter registration card

## HOW TO GET A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR ID

You must take the written driver's test first. To take the test, you will need to prove your identity, Social Security number, and residence address, using the process outlined in the gray part of this flowchart.
