



HB 378 PREVENT & END YOUTH HOMELESSNESS IN KY

- Increase homeless students' graduation rates by addressing the negative impacts of school mobility on high school graduation.
- Allow unaccompanied homeless youth to obtain their own birth certificates without parental consent and waive the fee.
- Facilitate access to mental health care for youth.

Increasing KY's graduation rate just 2% would generate \$8.3 million in spending, \$18 million in home sales, \$660,000 in state and local tax revenue, and \$19.5 million savings on health care.
